Speech of Axel Becker, Chairperson of the Bergisch Gladbach-Beit Jala

It was in 2001, when we, my wife Sabine and me, came the first time to the

bring together people of the three religions, Jewish, Christian and Islam. It  
was the vision of living together in peace even there exist deep differences

The mayor of that time, Raji Zeidan, explained to us, that Beit Jala and its people would highly appreciate an official partnership with a German town, as it exists between Bethlehem and the city of Cologne.

After this beginning we visited at least once in every year this wonderful town and we fell in love with its people. We brought citizens from Bergisch Gladbach, to share this experience and to see, what the life is here. They came back and talked about their experience to their families and friends in Germany.

In this process the Twin City Agreement of the year 2011 was born. After it, citizens of Bergisch Gladbach established the "Twinning Association" with today 180 members. The Association promotes and organizes many activities, and we could welcome various persons and organizations of Beit Jala in our town. With our municipality and actually with our mayor Lutz Urbach, we share mutual support in all twinning affairs with Beit Jala.

To express the vision of our Association we found the motto "Brücken statt Mauern", that means: Bridges instead of Walls. We had in mind the walls, which we saw in Beit Jala, the separation wall, which deeply affects the life of the citizens. The hope is, that it should fall down one day, as we Germans experienced in Berlin in the year 1989.

But today, standing on this newly named Bergisch Gladbach Square we see more walls under this bridge. We feel the bitterness of you, who have lost the lovely green areas of Cremisan. And also, we sometimes deplore, that our dreams of peace and justice for our twinned city are seriously threatened or even destroyed.

But today, dear friends in Beit Jala, being at your site on this square, we will bring you the message: We will not give up!

We will not give up our hope, our work for peace and understanding, our friendship with you.

Since a few days ago the famous Queen of Soul, Aretha Franklin, passed away, and we could see how millions of people all over the world are touched by her music and her personal commitment. Especially when she insisted:
